Choir begins facing front. (*A Christmas carol*) Pivot right with both arms down at side (*we bring to You*) left arms raises straight with palm facing up from side to center
With left arm remaining raised at the center mark pivot body back to center. Left arm should be stretched away from body referring to the audience (*peace on earth*) slowly move left arm from left to right.
With bent knees, bend to the right and then to the left (*back to center*) have ones hands cup the mouth and bounce right then to the left (*back to center*) Remain facing center with hands cupping mouth and straight legs
(*A Christmas carol*) hands stretched in high diagonals with flexed hands (*in our hearts*) bring arms down from high diagonals to overlapping the heart, right over left (*hold*) drop arms to low diagonals
Raise arms from low diagonals to high diagonals, palms facing up
Cascade arms back down to sides from the high diagonals to the low diagonals, arms end right at ones sides
